



Giuditta Cordero-Moss, Dr. juris (Oslo), PhD (Moscow), is a professor at the University of Oslo, where she teaches private international law, contract law and international commercial law. Since 2002, the former corporate lawyer has been acting as an arbitrator in international disputes under the arbitration rules of numerous institutions, as well as in ad hoc arbitration. She is, inter alia, member of the Curatorium of the Hague Academy of International Law; President of the Administrative Tribunal, European Bank for Reconstruction and Development; alternate member of the International Court of Arbitration of the ICC and Vice-President of the Board of Directors of the Norwegian Financial Supervisory Authority. She has published numerous books and articles in Norway and internationally and is often invited to lecture at universities and organisations, including the Hague Academy of International Law, with a series of lectures on Party Autonomy in International Commercial Arbitration (2014).
